92 Points - The 2019 Zinfandel Old Vine is also terrific, with a rounded, medium-bodied, seamless texture to go with lots of plum and darker strawberry fruits, supple yet present tannins, a great mid-palate, and notes of spice, licorice, and damp earth.

92 Points - Juicy and broad in pomegranate, blood orange and blackberry, this wine also offers tremendously appealing and complex seasonings of dried herb and black pepper. Balanced by underlying acidity, it shows the intensity and intellectual satisfaction of old vines.

93 Points - This has seriously fresh and deep aromas of ripe red plums that build into a palate that is packed with rich flavors of dark berries, plums and chocolate.
