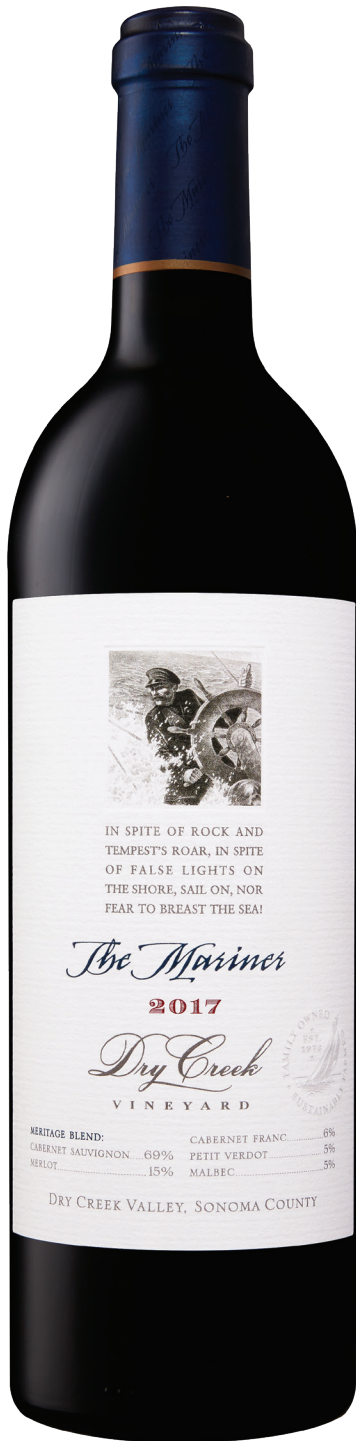

91 Points - Medium ruby; attractive, ripe, raspberry, dark cherry, and black currant aroma with hints of licorice, dried herbs, mint, green olive, and cocoa powder; full body; rich, elegant, nicely balanced, red and dark fruit flavors with herbal notes; full tannin; lingering aftertaste.

93 Points - This has rich aromas of blackberries and ripe cherries, as well as cedary oak. The palate has good poise and crisply detailed tannins, carrying plenty of ripe dark-berry flavor.

WINE ENTHUSIAST

90 Points - a seamless, full-bodied experience of dark chocolate, crushed rock and crisp berry fruit. Oak and tannin remain well-behaved and integrated, with lasting hits of cinnamon and clove that mark the close.
